



# AIR CARRIER MAIL AND AIR CARRIER MATERIALS, IN-FLIGHT SUPPLIES AND AIRPORT SUPPLIES



*The aim of this course is to ensure full compliance with the international regulations (ICAO, EASA, etc) as well with the National Authorities.*

*The main objective is to ensure that personnel involved in the handling of mail and air carrier materials, as well as personnel employed by other entities involved in the handling of in-flight and airport supplies, directly involved in the preparation of such supplies, other than security, may apply a standardized level of preventive security measures in order to protect civil aviation against acts of unlawful interference.*

*By the end of the course, the participants will be able to apply the security procedures imposed by the legislation in the field and to use them in the operational activity.*

## Syllabus

### MODULE 1 – CIVIL AVIATION SECURITY AWARENESS TRAINING

- Previous acts of illicit intervention in the field of civil aviation, terrorist acts and current threats;
- Applicable legal requirements;
- Objectives and organization in the field of civil aviation security;
- Obligations and responsibilities of persons applying security measures;
- Security checkpoint configuration;
- The security control process;
- Access control procedures and security control procedures;
- Airport ID cards;
- Reporting procedures;
- How to react appropriately in the event of security incidents.



## MODULE 2 - AIR CARRIER MAIL AND AIR CARRIER MATERIALS, IN-FLIGHT SUPPLIES AND AIRPORT SUPPLIES

- Previous acts of illicit intervention in the field of civil aviation, terrorist acts and current threats;
- Awareness of applicable legal requirements;
- The objectives and organization of aviation security, including the obligations and responsibilities of persons applying security measures;
- Security measures - Authorized known supplier of in-flight supplies;
- Security measures - Authorized known supplier of airport supplies;
- Security measures applied to air carrier mail and materials, in-flight and airport supplies;
- Requirements for the protection of air carrier mail and materials, in-flight and airport supplies;
- Transport security requirements;
- Procedures for challenging persons, as well as the circumstances in which the challenging or reporting of persons must be applied;
- Reporting procedures;
- How prohibited items can be disguised;
- How to identify prohibited items;
- How to react appropriately when prohibited items are detected.
