



PRACTICAL INSTRUCTOR TRAINING - practical (OSD On site demonstrator) -



The aim of this course is to ensure full compliance with the international regulations (ICAO, EASA, etc) as well with the National Authorities.

Target group: trainers performing ONLY practical training in a single workstream (e.g. ramp, driving on the apron, passengers' services – pending on local needs) the differences between a TTT and a practical instructor are:

- TTT can sign off a person for both, theory and practical assessment
- Practical instructor can assess and sign off (certify) staff only for practical training
- Practical instructor can sign off a person only in their area of expertise

The course is meant to develop the existing skills of the persons choose regionally in full according with the syllabus here below.

Syllabus

- Introduction
- Role of the practical instructor
- Responsibilities
- Basic principles of communication and listening
- Type of questions used during the practical training and assessment
- Empathy theory
- Safety measures
- Problems solving
- Learning styles
- Action plans
- Evaluation techniques

Course duration: 1 day / 8 hours for up to 6 participants

2 days / 10 – 14 hours for groups up to 8 – 10 participants (two trainers needed)

Note: second option is not recommended unless is very urgent!

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
